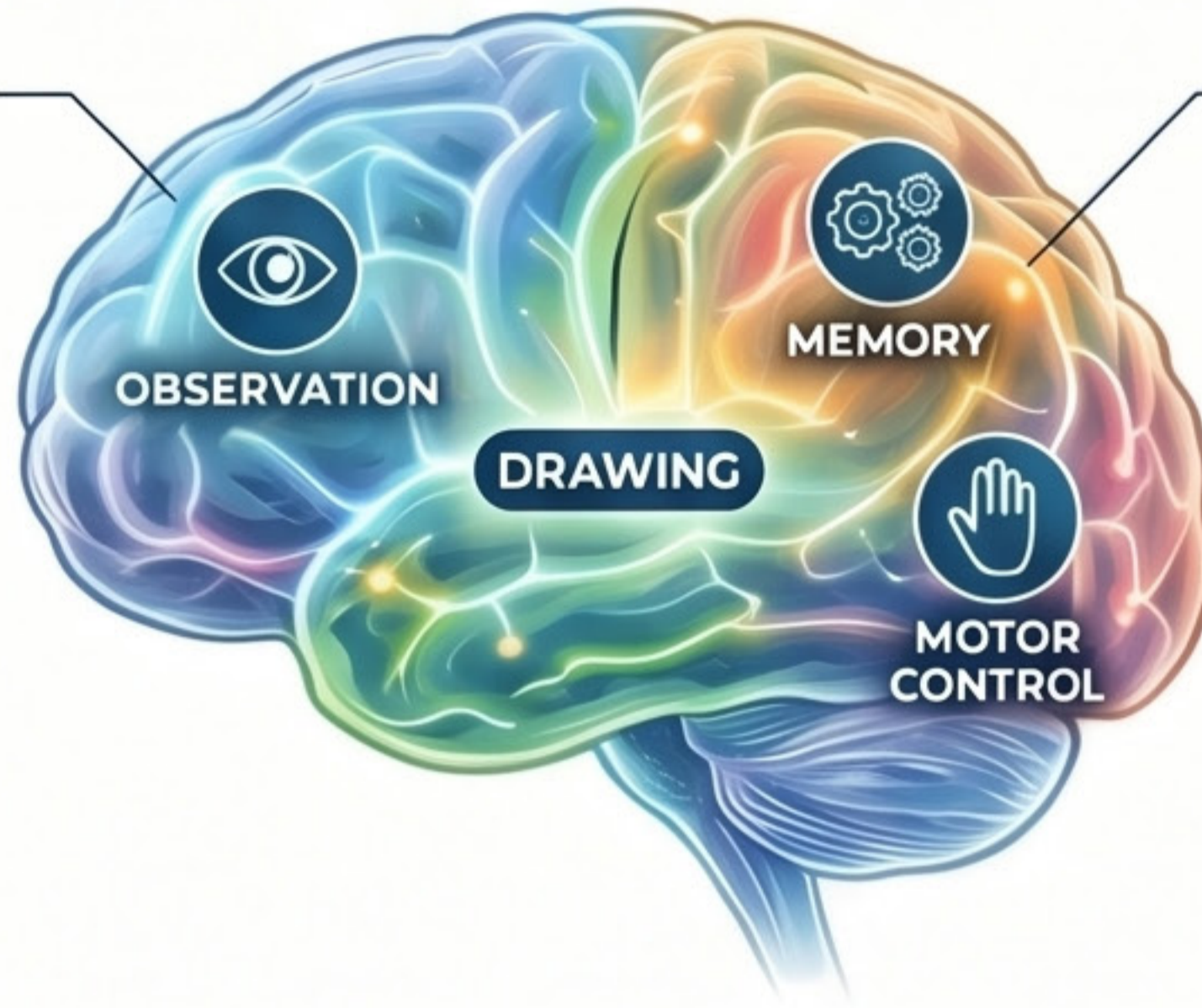
Drawing is a Way of Thinking:

Sketching is a cognitive process that simultaneously engages observation, memory, planning, movement, and imagination.



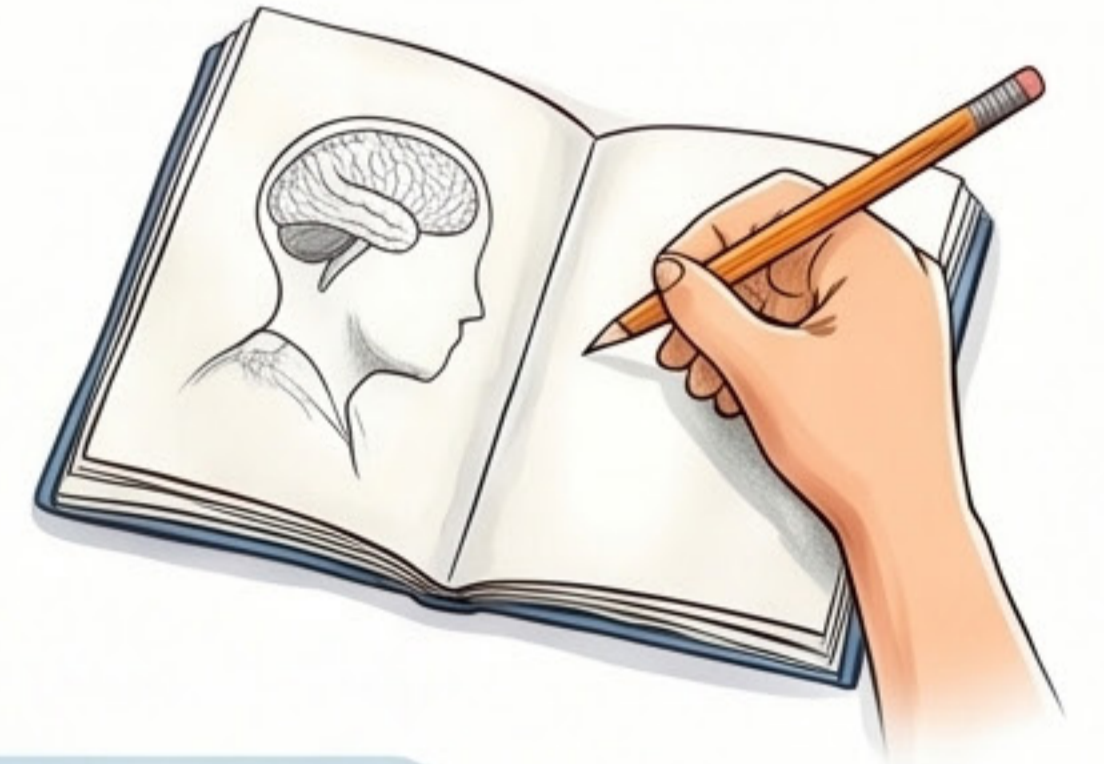
Ancient Communication:

Merely "label" objects



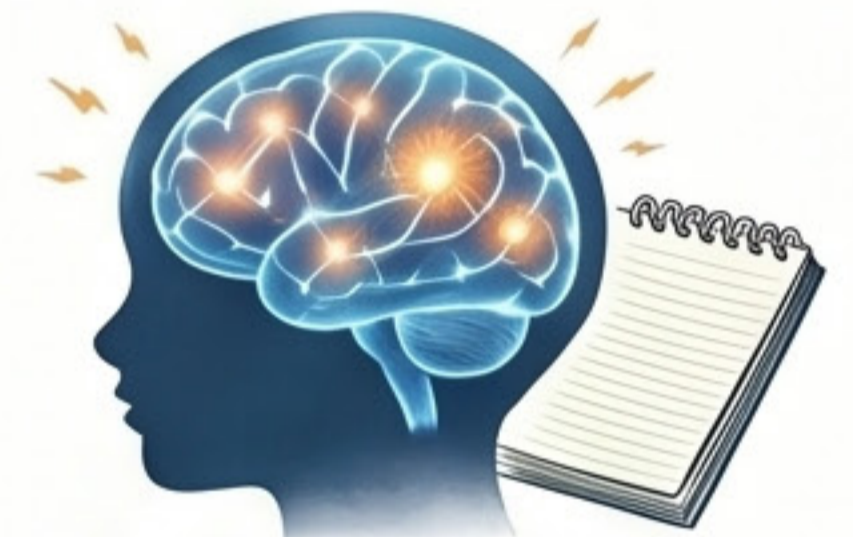
DEEP OBSERVATION

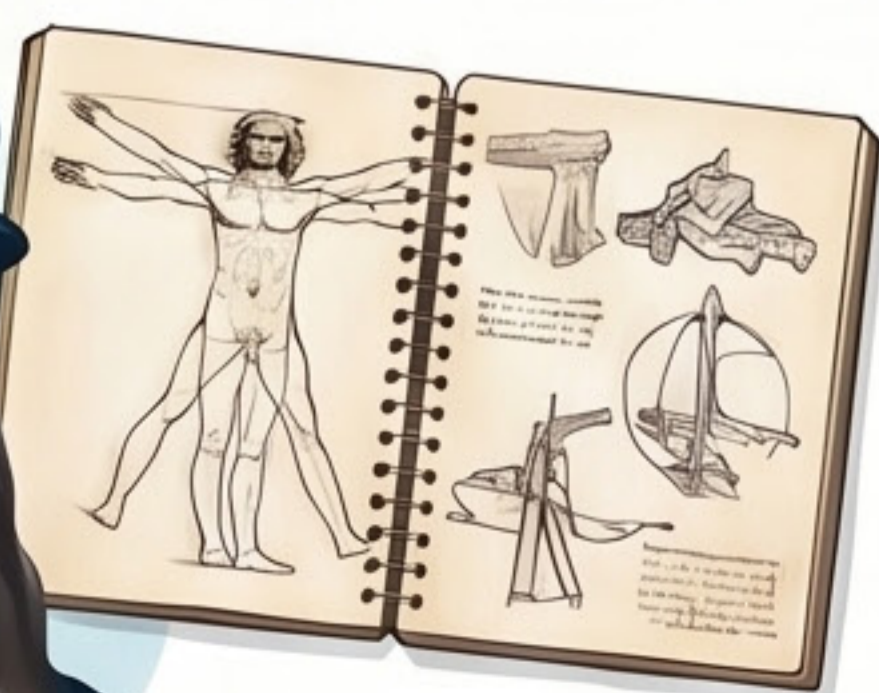
